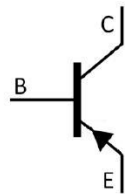

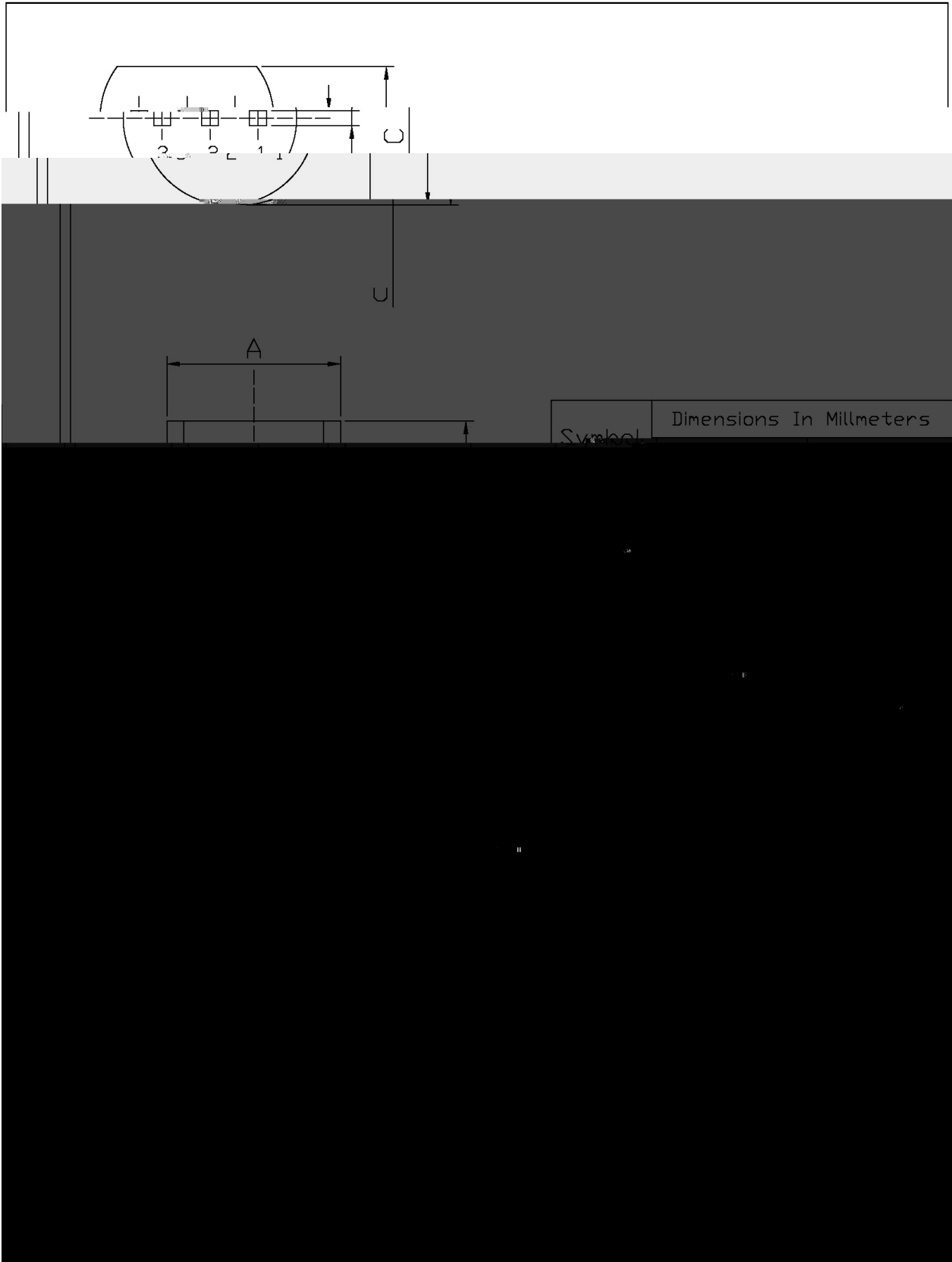

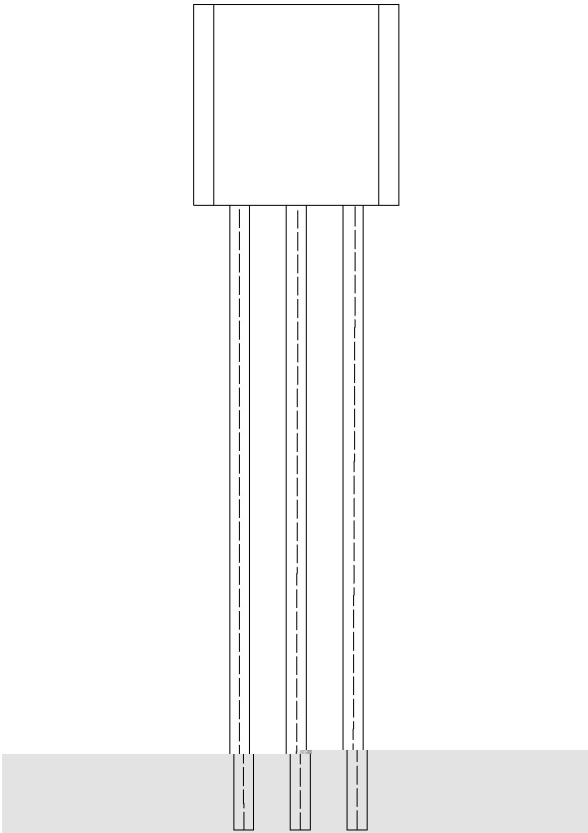

Figure 1 is a line graph showing the change in the number of individuals in the population of the common reed (*Phragmites australis*) in the Krasnodar Territory from 1990 to 2010. The Y-axis represents the number of individuals (0 to 100,000) and the X-axis represents the year (1990 to 2010). The population starts at approximately 10,000 in 1990, remains relatively stable until 1995, then increases sharply to a peak of about 90,000 in 2005, and finally decreases to approximately 60,000 in 2010.
